

## **YOUTH PRINTMAKING WORKSHOP at The 918 Bathurst Centre**

The 918 Bathurst Centre is hosting a one-day printmaking workshop as part of the Open Studio's *Printopolis Festival*, Saturday October 9, 2-4pm. Printopolis is a citywide festival celebrating the many forms of printmaking. Youth 10-18 years old will be introduced to the basic techniques involved in screen printing and stenciling.

Artists Tara Cooper and Nicholas Shick of the OCAD Printmaking Department, along with the help of OCAD students, will provide thorough demonstrations, and then the participants will each create their own original works. At least one work by each participant will be displayed in the Centre's new gallery space - Gallery 918 - for the duration of the Festival alongside Nicholas Shick's exhibition, *In Pursuit*.

To keep the workshop accessible, registration is only \$10.00.
